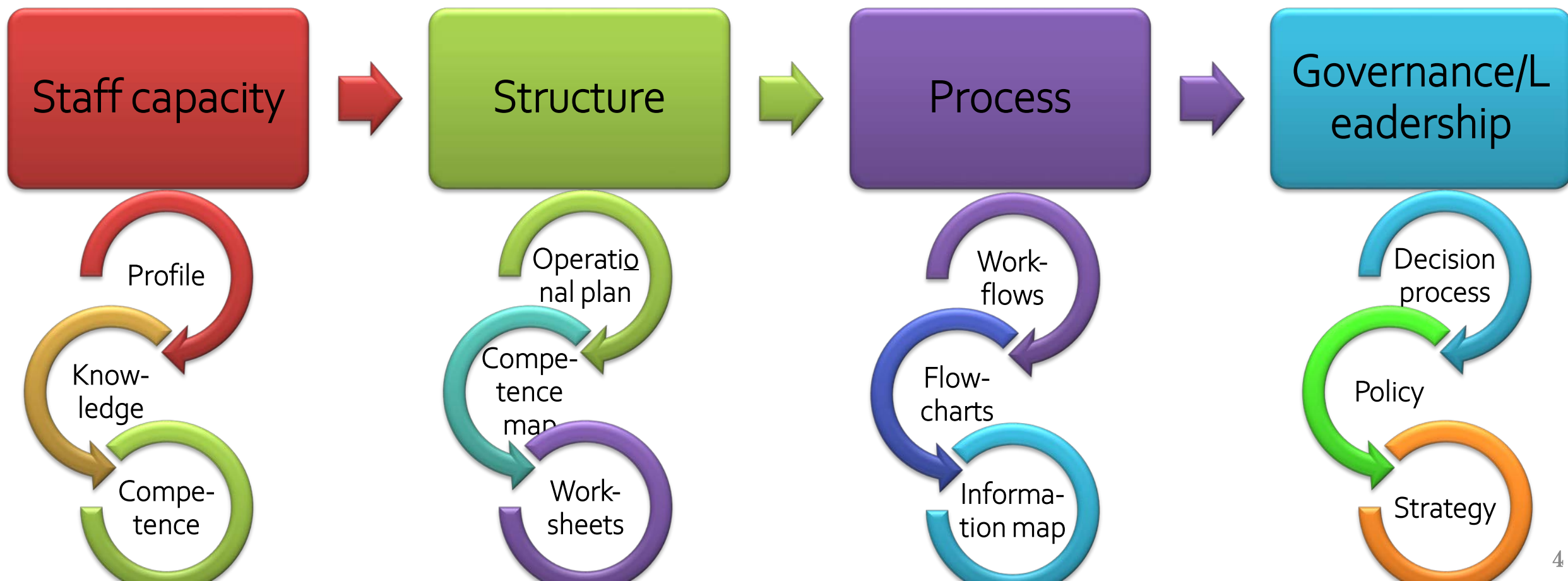

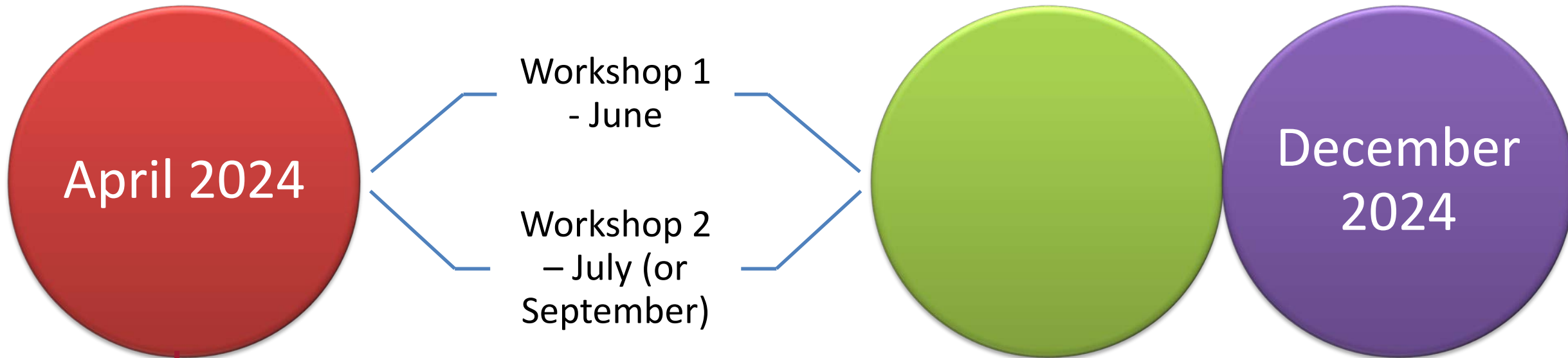
Aims and Results Work Package

1. **Évora (PT)**. Workshop on Erasmus+ opportunities – **June 13 and 14** (Thursday and Friday); exam period in Évora
Provide information on Erasmus+ opportunities, notably as regards KA1 mobilities and KA2 CBHE projects, eligibility criteria, funding rules and awards criteria (Erasmus+ programme guide as reference document)
2. **Quang Ninh Province (Vn)**. Workshop on Erasmus+ available tools – **September 10 and 11** (Tuesday and Wednesday)
 - (a) Allow acquiring with the tools made available by the European Commission for partnership building, search of funding, opportunities, Grant management and reporting; and
 - (b) benchmarking process from European Universities to Vietnamese Universities
