STRIVE-Strengthening Internationalization of Vietnamese Emerging Universities

Project: 101128558 — STRIVE — ERASMUS-EDU-2023-CBHE

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*Project sustainability has been developed following the needs analysis and the brainstorming with the Vietnamese partners, who expressed the interest to **create a simple structure capable of sustaining the engagement of Vietnamese universities' governance in the internationalization of their organizations beyond project life.***

STRIVE “Internationalization Virtual Centre” is the main sustainability outcome of the project .

The centre is expected to *enhance the visibility* of the internationalization strategies of the universities, the *monitoring of the international activities* of the targeted universities in the country, being *a reference point for an effective networking* and sharing of information among the Vietnamese partners and potential stakeholders on the internationalization opportunities offered by the Erasmus+ programme.

«Draft» General structure as by project proposal

- **Mission:** the internationalization virtual centre will stay as a reference point for an increased visibility of the international activities of the Vietnamese universities, as well as a tool for students, staff and universities to be acquainted with the opportunities given by the Erasmus+ programme, and a strategic network for a more effective information flow and a tool for monitoring the international activities in the higher education sector in the country
- **Structure:** online portal developed by Vietnamese beneficiaries with the support of EU partners.
- **Administration:** administrated by HANU for the first year following project end and on a rotating basis by the other beneficiaries.
- **Management:** an agreement aimed at detailing the roles, rights and obligations of each member of the centre will be drafted and signed by the 4 Vietnamese partners' legal representatives.
- **Resources:** as agreed in phase of project proposal, the founding members will provide their inner human resources, equipment and the needed facilities for allowing the centre to work beyond project life. The sustainability agreement to be signed will define the conditions.

The **virtual centre** will be **equipped with specific tools** (project deliverables) to be developed during project implementation:

- **Info sheet on international section of Vietnamese universities' websites-D.6.1.** at M24, based on UNITUS, UEVORA, AL, HANU experience, addressed at
 - students and staff inbound and outbound mobility: application procedure, how to get certificate of registration showing current enrolments, transcript of records from home university or from any other university and language test scores; courses offered, how to write a motivation letter, how to get visa and travel/health insurance, information for welcome week, on-campus and off-campus accommodation, and pre-departure proceedings for mobility participants on the university webpage, cultural differences, any other relevant information needed.
 - international relations office staff: how to apply to Erasmus+ calls for proposals, timetable, how to get new partners.

- **Monitoring tool on internationalization-D.6.2.** at M33, based on UEVORA experience
- constructed as *matrix* that will include a set of *key performance indicators*:
 - number of exchange programs, number of international students registered per year, country of origin of foreign students, number of collaborative projects, number of international research activities, number of international events hosted, number of international projects submitted per year, number of projects financed per year, number of international network members, number of staff and students involved in outbound mobilities.
